

Commencing October 1st 2010, the Center of Empirical Research in Economic and Behavioral Sciences (CEREB), University of Erfurt, awards

Doctoral and Post-doc scholarships

to candidates focussing on one or more of the following empirical research fields: **behavioural economics, econometrics, psychology, individual and group decision making, educational research, economics of education.**

The **CEREB** is an interdisciplinary collaboration of researchers in economics, psychology and organizational management working in the above areas.

As a successful candidate you will be able to work in an outstanding research environment. You will profit from an innovative conception of mutual team support and an intensive mentoring program. With your research you will be integrated into cross-disciplinary research teams, and you will receive systematic preparation for either an academic or non-academic career. The certified **CEREB graduate training program** offers you an interdisciplinary doctoral colloquium, workshops, a short lecture program, exchange possibilities with European universities, and financial support for participation in conferences.

Scholarships for PhD candidates are 1,000 per month and run for a period of up to 3 years. Postdoctoral scholarships are 1,500 per month and run for a period of up to 3 years. In Erfurt you will have a workstation at your disposal. Participation in the graduate training program is mandatory.

Requirements and necessary documents:

Applicants for Scholarships should hold a Master's or equivalent degree or a PhD in one of the relevant core areas. The following documents are required:

- an outline of the dissertation or postdoctoral project (approx. 5 pages, with a clear delineation of the topic as well as the current state of research, method of approach and hypotheses; must also include a work schedule and projected date of completion)
- curriculum vitae
- a copy of the applicant's undergraduate degree (can be submitted later)
- a copy of the applicant's master's thesis or doctoral dissertation
- a letter of recommendation or evaluation from a university teacher regarding the applicant's character and qualifications
- the applicant's choice of a research team.

Deadline for applications is **July 15th, 2010**.
